

FOOD SCRAP RECYCLING IN SLEEPY HOLLOW

Sleepy Hollow has joined with Tarrytown to participate in a food scrap recycling program! Sleepy Hollow residents can now bring ALL food scraps to the Food Scrap Drop-off Site next to the Tarrytown Senior Center in Pierson Park.

This program is for more than just backyard composting items: accepted items include fruits, vegetables, meat, fish, dairy, bread, rice, pasta, raw and cooked food, as well as cut flowers, napkins, paper towels and wax paper. The material is then brought to a compost facility and turned into soil!

How does it work?



Collect food scraps & paper products in a **countertop pail** using **compostable bags**



Store bags of food scraps in a **storage and transportation bin**



Bring your **storage and transportation** bin to the Food Scrap Drop-off Site at the Senior Center and empty into the totes there



What do I need to start?

Food scrap recycling “starter kits” make it easy and are available at the Warner Library and Sleepy Hollow Village Hall for \$23/kit.

Kits include:

- Countertop Pail
- Storage and Transportation Bin
- Roll of 25 Compostable Bags-Additional rolls are only \$2 at library
