1. Cleanup Planning:

Weber Park: All in order. Dan will probably deal with invasive species.

Devries Park: Change of the meeting with Glenn to assist Dave and Claire to communicate with Metro North to facilitate the clean up on the tracks. On April 10th at 10:00 Glen will meet at Devries and then set up a meeting with Anthony.

Claire pointed out there is no fencing by Quattro Field. No barriers.

Dave needs to make up a list of the equipment needed for the cleanup.
